THE STORY...

Students are participating in more activities than ever before. As activities grow, and participation increases, practice facilities become more and more limited. Students were practicing until 10 PM on school nights, with no time to fit in homework or family time. With this situation in mind, when the Schoenbrunn Racquet Club facility on East High Avenue became available at a reasonable price, the New Philadelphia Quaker Club made a commitment to purchase the facility for use by New Philadelphia City School District students.

The Quaker Club has been a long-standing support group for the New Philadelphia City Schools. The Club has undertaken several stadium projects; the locker room and turf replacement. Their dedication to New Philadelphia's youth has stood strong for decades, and their support for New Philadelphia youth has been invaluable. With most of the Quaker Club projects now paid in full, the Club made a commitment to purchase the Quaker Dome at a cost of \$695,000 to be paid over the next 10 years.

WHAT WILL THIS FACILITY BE USED FOR?

This facility will serve New Philadelphia City Schools and the community in a variety of ways. The first purpose is to serve the youth of our community. New Philadelphia has been blessed with a varied and diverse program offering extra and co-curricular activities. The varied program that has grown over the years has also created a need for space. The Quaker Dome will provide space for school and community programs. This spring the "Dome" was used for a full week in the kindergarten screening and registration process. A county math tournament is planned in the near future. Buckeye Career Center – Adult Education has used the Dome. This Fall an Ohio State University literacy event took place at the Dome. With excellent parking, events may take place at the Dome without disruption of school activities taking place in our school buildings.

HOW CAN I HELP?

First of all, remember that any donation to this project is tax deductible as a 501(C3). Help support this project by picking a category that fits you best! A donation of \$250,000 and you can "Name the Dome!" Imagine naming this facility after your family or a loved one. Name a Court at \$50,000 or Name a Practice Room for a \$25,000 donation. A dedication wall will pay tribute those who may wish to donate: \$5,000, \$2,500 or \$500. Every dollar donated will help to provide New Philadelphia Quakers with a better facility, better practice conditions, and ultimately support education in the New Philadelphia City School District. You may wish to make a pledge in memory of a loved one, a dedicated teacher or coach, or after one of your children or grandchildren. The choice is yours. A plaque commemorating your gift will forever be displayed in the Dome at the entrance of the facility.
