<u>College Credit Plus (previously Postsecondary) Program - New Philadelphia High School</u>

Important Information For Students and Parents

The College or University, not the High School, determines whether or not a student is admitted into the College Credit Plus (CCP) program, and if admitted, to what extent.

Students enrolled in CCP must be mature, independent, and responsible enough to handle the role of "college student." There is a high demand/expectation of study time outside the classroom in college courses. Additionally, there will be times during the school day when students will not be at NPHS or at college (travel time, no college classes on Friday, etc.) and therefore on their own without supervision.

Students are responsible for their own transportation to and from the college campus.

Students can not earn more than the equivalent of seven (7) total Carnegie units each school year. This is the total of credits earned at NPHS plus credits earned at the college. If a student goes over the equivalent of 7 Carnegie units, the student/parent will be responsible for paying the overage tuition.

Students must pass their college courses. Students/parents are responsible for paying the tuition for any failed college courses and for courses dropped after the deadline.

Athletes are responsible for providing their grades each nine weeks to the Athletic Department in order to provide proof of eligibility. It is important to note that in college, official grades are only given at the end of each semester. Therefore, students must acquire a report of their grades from their professor at the end of the first and third nine-weeks.

College policy stipulates that parents do not have access to their child's college information.

Only the student can request this information.

Students and parents are <u>required</u> to attend a CCP Information/Orientation Session hosted by the college. This event offers a true picture of expectations and allows for questions to be answered.

There may be schedule conflicts between NPHS and the college, so there is no guarantee that a student will be able to take all requested courses.

Students must notify NPHS of their interest in participating in the CCP Program by April 1s.
