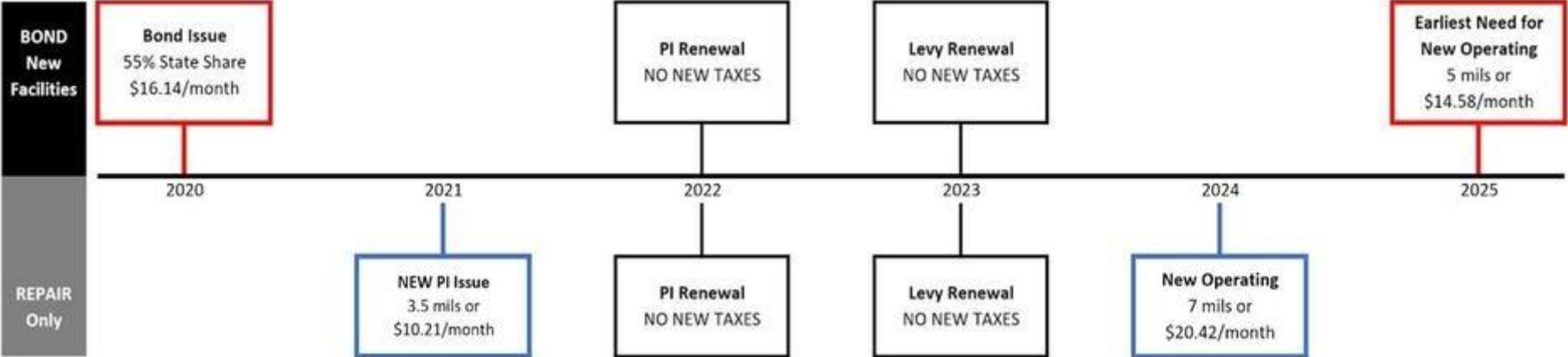

Considerations:	With The Bond	Without The Bond
Buildings	<p>New, Community-Driven, Cost-Effective Educationally-Appropriate Safe & Secure Facilities Addresses all Necessities Long-term, Comprehensive, Solution</p>	<p>Buildings remain overcrowded with kids learning in closets and trailers Does NOT address safety & security needs Operating costs for 8 buildings remain high Short-Term Solution</p>
Cost	<p>In 2020: State pays 55% of the overall cost. New Phila residents pay \$16.14 per month per 100K in home value while district saves \$600,000 per year in operating costs</p>	<p>In 2021: State pays nothing and New Phila residents pay 100% of the cost. District pays \$14.5 million for basic repairs and continues high operating costs for inefficient and dated buildings</p>
Future Operating Levies	<p>No new levy request until at least 2025 Better, Safer, & Cheaper</p>	<p>New, larger, levy request in 2024 to pay for ongoing operating and maintenance of 8 aging buildings District will still have to find a long-term solution to address aging facilities (safety & security, trailers, parking, traffic) without any state funding</p>
