

NEW PHILADELPHIA ATHLETICS - GAME DAY
PROTOCOLS
****TEAMS****

- *All athletes, coaches, officials, trainers, game personnel should be screened for signs/symptoms of COVID-19, to include a temperature check.
 - The home school will be responsible for screening their athletes, coaches, trainers, and game personnel, as well as the game officials upon arrival.
 - The visiting school will be responsible for screening (including a temperature check) all of their athletes and coaches before leaving their home school (visiting athletes not transported by district transportation will be required to wait for the arrival of their team so a symptom check can be conducted by their coach).
- *All athletes, coaches, officials, trainers, game personnel will be required to wear a mask. Only when players are participating in physical activity (i.e. warming up and the game/match) will they be permitted to remove their mask.
- *All athletes, coaches, officials, trainers and game personnel should practice social distancing at all times when not participating in physical activity.
- *Players should come dressed and ready to go as much as possible.
- *Please have your mask on immediately upon leaving your bus or car.
- *Go to your appropriate spot in the bleachers/sideline.
- *Enter the stadium via the ticket booth area, then proceed to the bench area of your appropriate sideline.
- *Athletes maintain social distancing of 6 feet when not on the field and wear your masks
- *Athletes entering the locker room must have a mask and social distance when possible
- *Coaches must wear face covering at all times
- *Visiting teams are to supply their own water, towels and personal equipment. Players are not to share water bottles, towels and are to have their own water bottle/towel
- *All athletes, coaches, officials, trainers and game personnel should bring their own water/hydration and towel. Water fountains and water coolers will not be provided by NPCS.
- *LOCKER ROOMS (Available at WHQS and NPHS Gymnasium):
 - Locker Rooms will be cleaned and sanitized prior to visiting team's arrival and use of Facility.
 - Participants should wear masks in the locker room.
 - Discourage changing of clothes and showering at the facility.
 - Assure safe distances in the locker room at a minimum of six feet between occupants.
 - Consider a rotating schedule for players in and out of the locker room (and training areas) to avoid potential congestion.

****SPECTATORS****

Pre-Arrival

- *Spectators must conduct daily symptom assessments.
- *Anyone experiencing symptoms must stay home.
- *Each Venue will have Attendance Limitations.
 - No Tickets will be sold at the gate for Varsity Football Games.
 - WHQS for other Events - Sales at the door will be available. Workers will take a count of all fans. If we get to capacity (940), no more tickets will be sold.
 - Southside Community Park: 400 Tickets Available
 - Season Ticket Holders are guaranteed admittance.
 - 75 Ticket Vouchers for the Opponent
 - Tickets will be sold at the Gate until capacity is reached.
 - NPHS Gymnasium - 300 tickets Available
 - Season Ticket Holders are guaranteed admittance.
 - 75 Ticket Vouchers for the Opponent
 - 24 Student Tickets Available
 - Tickets will be sold at the Gate until capacity is reached.

When You Arrive

- *Spectators should not arrive more than 30 minutes before your child's game.
- *Please social distance while you are in line.
- *Please have your mask on immediately upon exiting your car.
- *Enter the stadium via the ticket booth area, then proceed to your team's bleachers.
- **No congregating before, during or after games is permitted.*
- *Hand sanitizer will be available at the ticket booth and concession stand (if open).

During the Game

- *Family and household members are to sit together socially distanced from individuals/family/household groups
- *Spectators must wear face coverings at all times except for any of the allowable exceptions stated in the Director's Order for Facial Coverings throughout the State of Ohio.
- *Please practice good hand hygiene and respiratory etiquette.

*Individuals must maintain social distancing as much as possible while in the restrooms. Face coverings must be worn at all times while in the restrooms.

*To help with social distancing, spectators have the option to stand/sit at the fence post. If you choose to stand, please place yourself in front of the section breaks in the fence.

*No spectators are allowed on any of the playing surfaces before, during or after the contest.

*The north section of bleachers will be designated as away. The south section of the bleachers and field house end zone bleachers will be designated as home. Bleachers at the scoreboard end of the stadium will be for the Band and NPHS Students. Please seat yourself accordingly.

When You Leave

*Exit the bleachers at the conclusion of the game and exit at either end of the stadium.

*Once a spectator leaves a contest, he/she will not be permitted to return.

*Please leave immediately after your child has completed his/her game.

*No congregating before or after games is permitted.
