



- 1. Passengers should arrive at bus stop five minutes before the bus arrives.
- 2. Passengers must wait in their designated place of safety until the bus door opens.
- 3. Behavior at the school bus stop must not threaten life, limb, or property of any individual.
- 4. Passengers must go directly to an available or assigned seat.
- 5. Passengers must remain seated, keeping an inside quiet voice.
- 6. Passengers must not put head, arms, hands or any part of their body out of a bus window.
- 7. Aisle and exits must remain clear at all times.
- 8. Passengers must observe classroom conduct.
- 9. Passengers must not use profane language.
- 10. Passengers must not eat or drink on the bus.
- 11. Passengers must not use tobacco on or around the bus.
- 12. Passengers must not have alcohol or drugs in their possession on or around the bus except for prescription medication required for a passenger.
- 13. Passengers must not throw or pass objects on, from, or into the bus.
- 14. Passengers may carry on the bus only objects that can be held in their laps and must be kept sealed and put away at all time.
- 15. Passengers must not use electronic devices except when instructed to do so by authorized staff. Cell phones and electronic devices should be turned off and put away at all times.
- 16. Passengers must load or unload only at their designated bus stop or location to which they have been assigned.
- 17. Passengers should always unload in a zigzag order.
